Activities and Accomplishments: 2008-09

Since its establishment in September 2002 the department heads of the four Curriculum Centers meet between 3-4 times a year. The committee is composed of curriculum Center managers/librarians from each of the CSU campuses. The Committee is a vehicle for collaboration, coordination and information sharing in support of the four CSU Curriculum Materials Centers. We exchange expertise, knowledge and collection center goals at each meeting, and share information and materials of benefit to our respective institutions and to the CSU System as a whole. Some of our topics have been technology related and focus on Web 2.0. Committee work has resulted in several initiatives and projects, including publishing the *Curriculum Center Notes* newsletter, developing new brochures and guides, a committee website, etc. Due to the retirement of two of our members our progress and meetings have slowed a bit. With this being said the remaining members continue to work as a team to accomplish some of our goals. This year we have accomplished the following:

Last summer we collaborated together with the CSU directors and others to get a Curriculum Center Scope.

Twice a year we publish a themed newsletter in hardcopy and have also put the newsletter on our websites. All Curriculum Center Heads contribute articles to the newsletter and the ECSU CC Librarian formats the newsletter.

We have a shared website that Western's Public Service Librarian maintains. All of the CC heads contribute to Websites content.

Eastern and Western's Librarians are currently exploring how to make use of social networking/library technologies, including Springshare Lib Guides.

We have worked on a survey, but due to the retirements have not made much progress.
